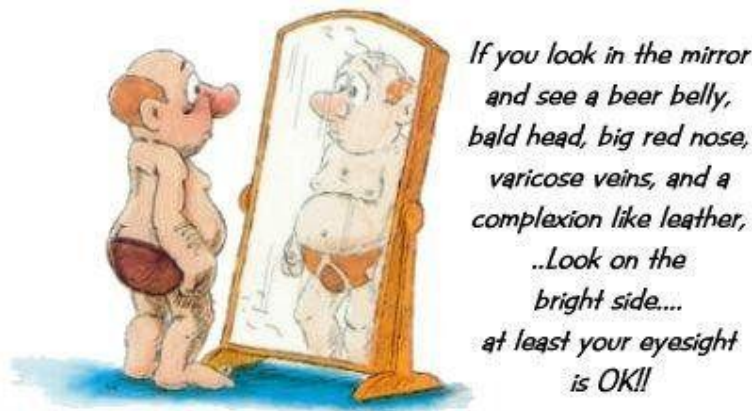


The family is sitting at the dinner table. The son asks his father, "Dad, how many kinds of boobies are there?"
